



Chris Cloutier has practiced international trade law since 1999. From 2002 through 2005, Mr. Cloutier served as the senior officer at the United States Embassy in China for the section of the U.S. Department of Commerce tasked with administering the U.S. antidumping and countervailing duty laws. He is currently a partner at the law firm Schagrin Associates in Washington DC. He is recognized as a leader in the field by publications such as SuperLawyers™ and Who's Who Legal™.

Schagrin Associates was founded in 1984 and specializes in advising domestic producers in trade remedy proceedings and corporations and governments in dispute settlement proceedings before the World Trade Organization. The firm is responsible for approximately one out of every four antidumping and countervailing duty orders.
